**TEMPORARY ORDER SEALING FILE PENDING COURT'S HEARING ON  
HUSBAND'S MOTION TO MAKE COURT RECORDS CONFIDENTIAL**

UPON CONSIDERATION of the parties' fully executed *Joint Stipulation Regarding Financial Information Filed with the Court and Husband's Motion to Make Court Records Confidential*, which have been filed with the Court, and the Court having reviewed the file and being otherwise fully advised in the premises does make the following Findings of Fact:

- 1) On or about February 16, 2011, Husband filed a Motion to Make Court Records Confidential pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420 to. A copy of the Motion is attached hereto and marked "Exhibit A."
- 2) On or about March 1, 2011, Husband and Wife entered into a Joint Stipulation Regarding Confidentiality of Financial Information Filed with the Court. A copy of the Stipulation is attached hereto and marked "Exhibit B."
- 3) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420 states that upon the filing of the Motion to Make Court Records Confidential, the Clerk is to treat information subject to the Motion as confidential pending the Court's ruling on the Motion.


- 4) The Court has not ruled on this Motion.

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED:

2. That all documents filed with the Court in the future in Case No: 11-DR-000015-DS shall be sealed by the Clerk of Court.



**HUSBAND'S MOTION TO MAKE COURT RECORDS CONFIDENTIAL**

COMES NOW the Husband, ALLEN R. WEISS, by and through the undersigned counsel, pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420, files this *Motion to Make Court Records Confidential* and states as follows:

1. Pending before the Court is Husband's Petition for Dissolution of Marriage.
2. The pending matter involves sensitive financial information, which if disclosed to the public, could subject either party to extortion, invasion of privacy, tortuous interference with an advantageous business relationship or other substantial injury.
3. Due to the sensitive nature of the information and the risk of harm if exposed, the parties' have a privacy interest in keeping the financial information filed with the Court confidential.
4. Based upon the sensitive information contained in the financial records of the parties, the Husband believes the financial records of the parties filed with the Court

(including but not limited to Financial Affidavits) should be kept confidential and sealed from public view.

5. The records which should be sealed and kept confidential include but are not limited to the parties' Financial Affidavits, social security numbers, bank account numbers, bank account balances, tax returns, credit card numbers, credit card balances, investment account numbers, investment account balances, retirement account numbers, retirement account balances, life insurance account numbers and policies, dividend payments from securities, royalty payments from investments, personal financial statements provided to lending institutions, personal loan applications provided to lending institutions, pledges of charitable gifts and promissory notes issued to lending institutions not otherwise in the public record.

6. Pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420, the Clerk of Court should keep all financial records of the parties, as outlined in Paragraph 5 above, confidential and sealed from public view, pending the Court's ruling on Husband's motion.




